The project "Peatland Management and Rehabilitation" aims to develop the planning and implementation capacities to rehabilitate peatland ecosystems in the Kayan Sembakung Delta, North Kalimantan. It is supported through a cooperation between the government of Indonesia and the government of the Federal Republic of Germany. The project responds to the current land use plannings and practices in the Kayan Sembakung Delta which are considered insufficient. It brings forward the protection and sustainable management of the peatland ecosystems.
